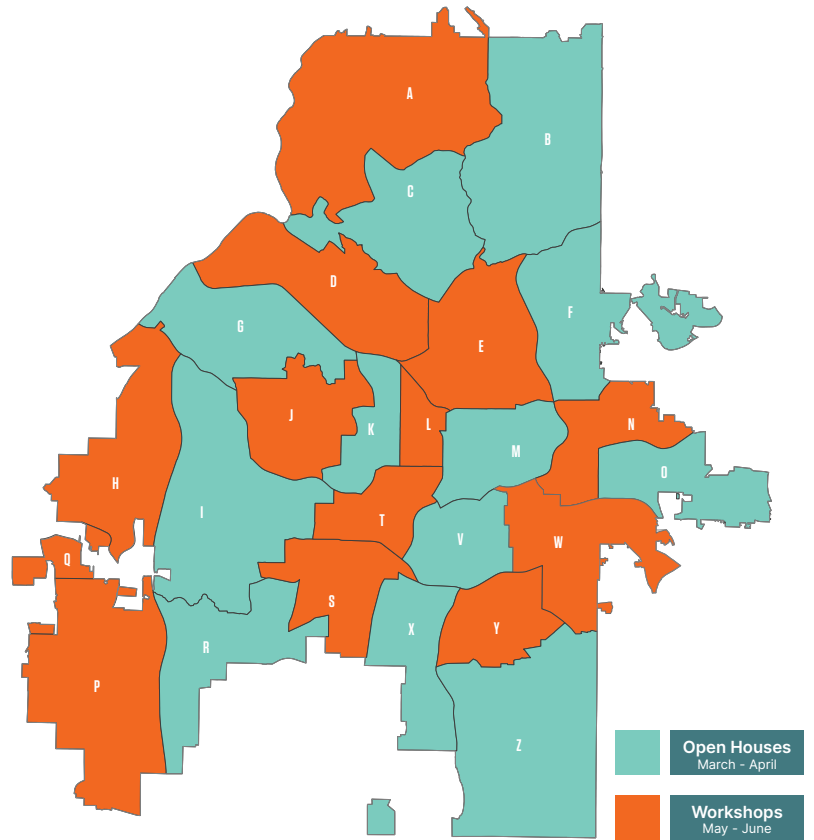

Atlanta is divided into 25 NPUs, which are resident advisory councils entrusted with communicating residents' input to shape Atlanta's future. Atlanta's first African American Mayor, Maynard Jackson, signed the legislation creating the NPU system 50 years ago, in 1974.

Mayor Jackson sought to ensure all Atlantans had a voice in decision-making at City Hall, especially in the Comprehensive Development Plan.

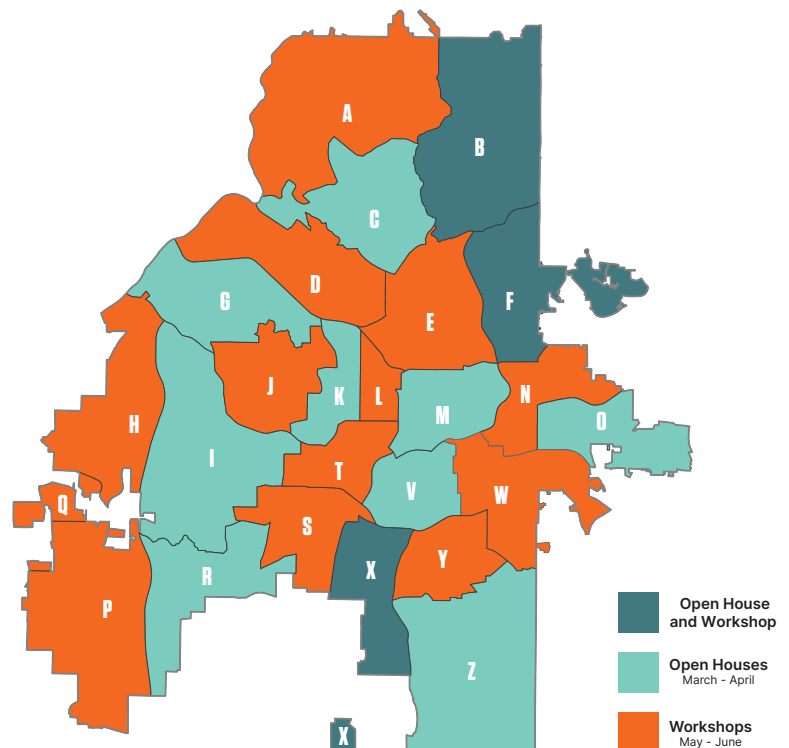
The main objective of the Community Workshops is to continue building consensus on the maps and policy statements for Plan A.
